DESCRIPTION: Autobiographical Book Cover w/ Illustrated Title

- OBJECTIVES:**
1. Design a Book Jacket (This doesn't mean copy an existing one.) based on your life story (i.e., If you were to write a book about your life, what would the cover for it look like?). The possibilities are endless so don't limit yourself.
 2. This is a comprehensive assignment. Use any or all aspects of Photoshop relevant to your design solution.

- DIRECTIONS:**
1. After deciding on a design solution for your cover, explore possible design solutions for your title.
 2. Design front & back cover, including flyleaves, and spine as well. For size and proportions use obtain measurements from an existing book jacket.
 3. Collect source material from personal photographs, magazines, etc. Use imagery that is appropriate for your project. Stock photography may be employed as well.
 4. Work 200-300 p.p.i.

SAVE YOUR PROJECT FREQUENTLY WHILE YOU ARE WORKING

MATERIALS: Photoshop, Scanned images (flat bed, digital camera, etc.), Stock Photography, Mat board

PRESENTATION: Present work in a finished comprehensive form. All covers must be mounted on black or gray mat board.
