DESCRIPTION: | Design a personal website using the robust Adobe software Dreamweaver.

OBJECTIVES: | Learn and experience the concepts of website design using the website builder Dreamweaver, where the understanding of HTML and CSS is necessary.

DIRECTIONS: |

1. Design a personal website containing at least 2 pages or a single page with 2 sections.
2. This project should be designed as your personal website. If this topic isn't suitable to you, redesign and existing website or design a website for a fictitious company, band, soccer team, etc.
3. Collect photos, drawings, and other content that will serve as a foundation for your website.
4. The format for this website should be 1200 x 800 pixels.
5. Your design may be predominantly text with some images.
6. Incorporate a WowSlider slideshow with at least 6 slides.
7. Use my personal website at kmart66.com as a template for what I expect from this assignment.
8. Create a free 000webhost.com account and use their cPanel to publish your website. Make sure you upload your index.html and assets into your public folder.
9. Aesthetics and overall design are certainly important, but more important, your website must be functional (i.e., it must work).
