DESCRIPTION: Restore/retouch a photograph

OBJECTIVES:

1. Restore and retouch (if necessary) a damaged family photo to its original condition.
2. Use any or all tools necessary for restoring your photograph to remove "all" imperfections.

DIRECTIONS:

1. Search through old family photos and find one that is damaged. (The photo need not be old but should be one that is "in focus" and damaged (torn, creased, water damaged) but restorable.
2. Should the photo require additional retouching such as color balance, levels, etc., do what is necessary.
3. Scan the photo (300ppi) at its original size. You may scan it to a larger size if you wish.
4. Use any or all tools / techniques you have learned this semester to restore and retouch the photo, so it looks new, again. Better than new, if that's possible.

SAVE YOUR PROJECT FREQUENTLY WHILE YOU ARE WORKING!!!

Your grade will be based on technique used and quality of completed work.

MATERIALS: Photoshop, Scanned family photograph

PRESENTATION: Present work in a finished comprehensive form. Save photos on data disk (CD). All restored / retouched photos should be presented beside the original (Before & After).
