2. Select one of the attached templates. There is a Skateboard deck, several T-shirts, and a Purse.
3. Decide on a theme you would like to apply to one of the aforementioned products.
4. Collect photos, drawings, etc., that will serve as a foundation for your illustration.
5. Use any or all of the Illustrator tools you have learned to develop your own interpretation of these graphics.
6. Your solution does not have to look like Simone's Tokidoki characters. I'm having you look at his work for "inspiration" only.

Your grade will be based on concept, overall design, and technique.

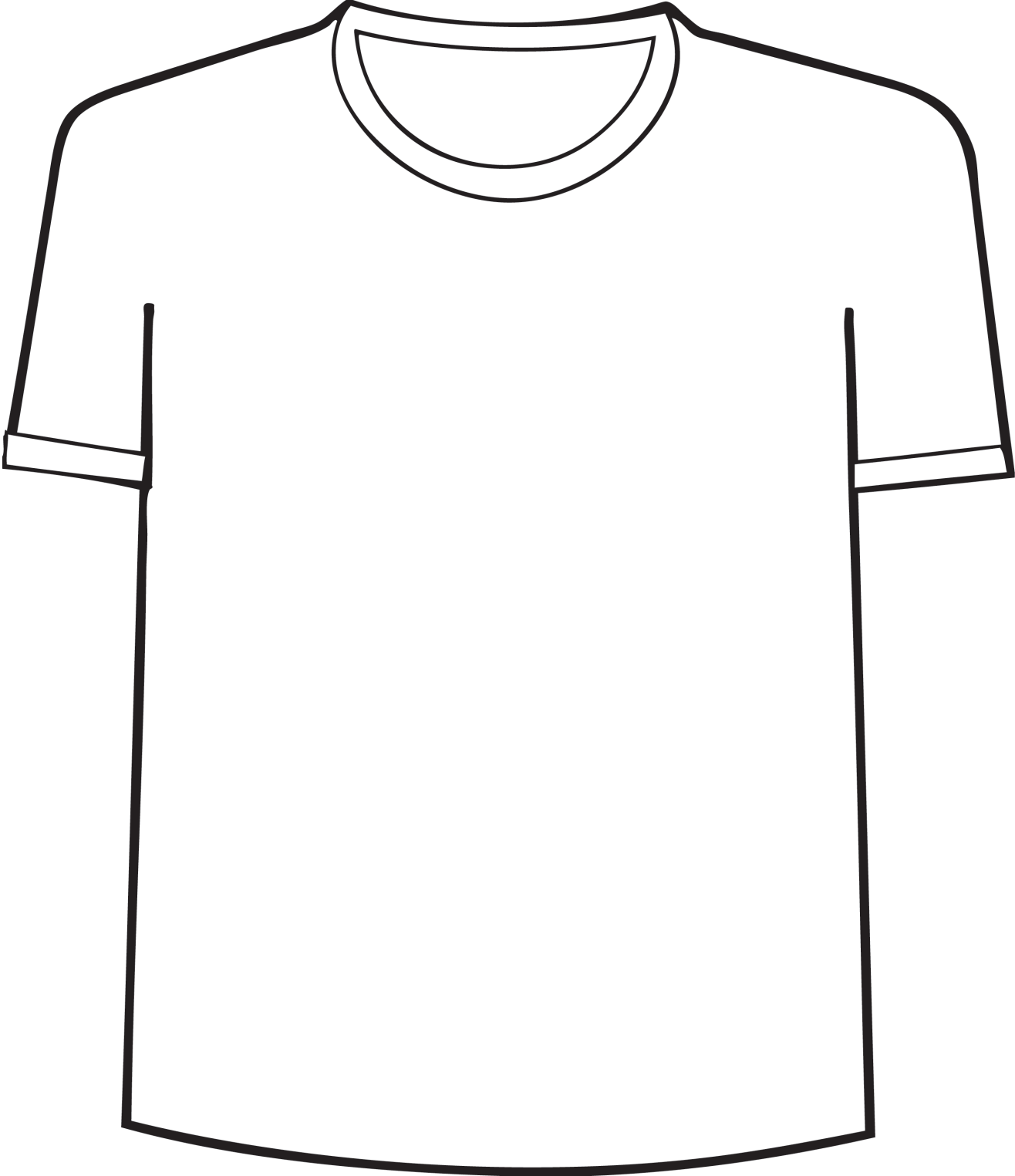
MATERIALS: | Adobe Illustrator, Scanned images (flat bed scanner, digital camera, etc.), Stock Photography

Skateboard Deck Template



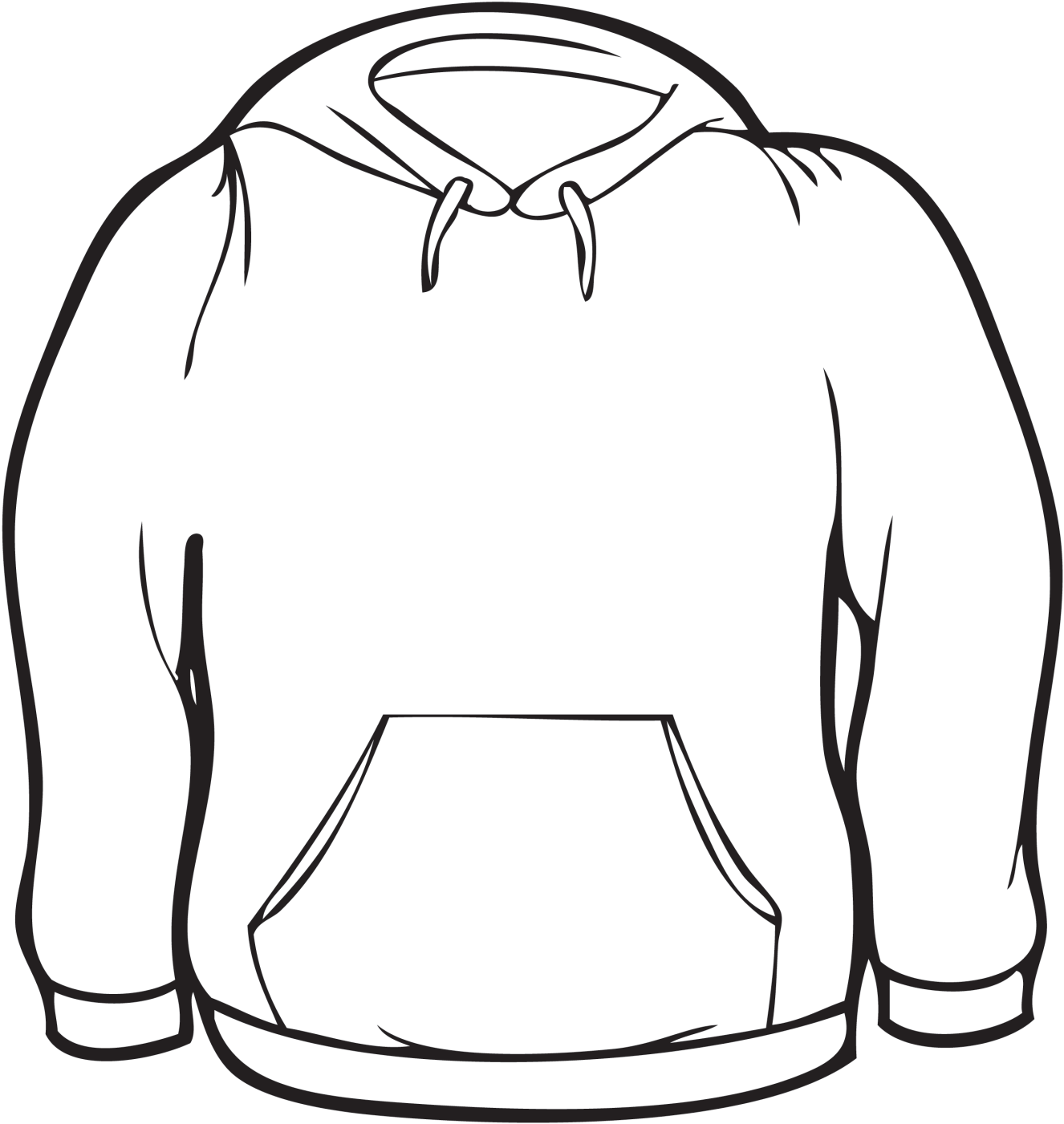
T-shirt Template #1
